



DALLAS HERITAGE VILLAGE

Nestled in 13 wooded acres just south of downtown Dallas, Dallas Heritage Village provides visitors, young & young at heart, a unique museum experience. Dallas Heritage Village is a living history museum portraying life in North Texas from 1840-1910. Their mission is to collect, preserve and teach the history of Dallas and North Central Texas. Located in historic Old City Park, the museum uses its collections of historic buildings and furnishings, representing the period 1840-1910, to sponsor research, publications and exhibits, and to present educational programs and special events for diverse audiences of children, families and adults. The museum is composed of 38 historic structures & boasts a working Civil War era farm, a traditional Jewish household, elegant Victorian homes, a school, a church & commercial buildings.

Dallas Heritage Village is host year-round to corporate events, weddings, company picnics and conventions. Accommodations are available for events ranging in size from 20 guests to 2,000. A list of approved caterers, selected for the quality of their services, their ability to meet legal, TABC and insurance requirements, their commitment to following museum catering guidelines, and the ability to serve customers in all budget ranges, is available. Events are permitted to have alcoholic beverages; however Dallas Heritage Village does not have a liquor license and cannot take possession of or store alcohol in any form under any circumstances. Dallas Heritage Village requires only TABC certified bartenders distribute alcoholic beverages, and we are not responsible for any damages resulting from any failure to obtain these permits. There is an additional Mixed Beverage Fee for anything other than beer, wine and champagne, and additional liability waivers might be required. This includes Margarita machines, frozen drink machines, etc.
